<p><u>Church Activities</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Worship celebrated online only • Other activities in the church building cancelled • Meetings and small groups scheduled virtually only • Church office hours may be reduced 	<p><u>Church Activities</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Worship streaming continues online • Worship in-person limited to 65 household units in the sanctuary • No in-person meetings, small groups, music rehearsals, Sunday School, or nursery • Virtual meetings may continue • Building open but by appointment only 	<p><u>Church Activities</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Worship streaming continues online • Worship in-person resumes • Other activities and regular use of space resume • Meetings and small groups resume • Large events resume
<p><u>Health and Safety Guidelines</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals with fever or illness must stay home • Strict social distancing in all areas • Masks required in common areas • Hand sanitizer stations available • Handshakes/hugs prohibited • Intensive cleaning of high-touch points in the building • Depending on conditions, staff may arrange to work remotely 	<p><u>Health and Safety Guidelines</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals with fever or illness must stay home • Individuals with known risk conditions are encouraged to stay home • Strict social distancing required in all areas • Spaced seating as indicated in pews • Masks required in common areas • Hand sanitizer stations readily available • Handshakes/hugs prohibited • Nursery not available • Coffee Hour conducted remotely • Hymnals and pew Bibles removed from pews • “Drop-off” locations for offering (e-tithing encouraged) • Congregational singing not permitted, but music continues with soloists/quartet/instrumentalists • Communion will not be celebrated as part of the in-person worship service, but in a separate virtual eucharistic service • Intensive cleaning of high-touch points 	<p><u>Health and Safety Guidelines</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individuals with fever or illness must stay home • Masks are not required • Hand sanitizer stations available • Handshakes/hugs permitted • Nursery open • Coffee Hour open • Normally spaced seating in pews • Regular offering • Hymnals and pew Bibles available • Normal communion resumes • Singing is encouraged • Regular cleaning resumes
